Handling and Care Instruction for your Etched Glass

Read Carefully Important

- When installing etched glass, we suggest wearing clean, soft gloves. Failure to do so may result in permanent stains. It is very important that the etch surface be protected from installer's body oils (such as sweat, fingerprints, etc.). Once the glass is installed and construction ceases the etched glass will no longer be as vulnerable to stains. If installed following these simple rules, the customer will be satisfied with their new etched glass for many years!
- Install the etched surface facing areas where it will be most sheltered. If possible, avoid exposure to the elements (water, rain, dirt, etc.), as well as fingerprints and heavy traffic areas.

Please note: when surface becomes completely wet, the etched glass will appear clear.

- Do not allow dirt/debris or moisture to remain on etched surfaces. Clean glass surfaces following the instructions below.
 - All surfaces should be cleaned with normal glass cleaner available through janitorial supply companies. Such spray products may include Glass Plus, Windex or foam spray glass cleaning products.
 - All surfaces should be cleaned with **white soft rags only**. It is important that rags are clean and used only for glass cleaning purposes. These are available at hardware and janitorial supply companies. **Paper products should never be used when cleaning glass or mirrors**. Their fibers adhere to the etched surface.
 - **DO NOT SCRUB** or use **ABRASIVE CLEANSERS** on etched areas to remove dirt or stains. A gentle cleaning is recommended to avoid damaging the protective coating.
- If you follow the above instructions, your glass will look beautiful for many years to come.
